Kay Starkey from West Midlands Air Ambulance.

Kay came along and gave us a very informative talk about the West Midlands Air Ambulance (MAAC) which first started in 1991. They are involved in assisting ill or injured patients and getting them to hospital as quickly as possible. They attend all traumatic incidents and remote locations where ambulances cannot travel. They cover 6 counties. Gloucestershire, Herefordshire, Shropshire, Staffordshire, Worcestershire and west Midlands. Our nearest base is RAF Cosford. Each craft carries a crew of Pilot, 2 paramedics or 1 paramedic and a flight doctor and full life supporting medical equipment. They also have 3 Critical Cars, which usually attend at night or when the weather is too bad for a helicopter to fly safely. Kay advised that the crew on board can perform lifesaving operations (such as open-heart surgery, amputations) on site before transporting the patient to a hospital best suited to treat the condition / injuries. This is not always the nearest to where they live. Each helicopter mission costs £2,950. Critical cars missions cost £288; all this

can amount to £11 – 12 million per year. When you dial 999 the dedicated staff there make the decision if MAAC should be deployed.

I am proud to say that WRSG members rallied round and made personal donations adding up to £94.46, put together with the groups donation we were able to hand Kay a cheque for £145.
